#### CALL TO ORDER

Chairman, Ms. Karen Hodock, called the Continued Meeting of May 11, 2016 to order.

#### AGENDA

\*\*\*\*\*MOTION to approve the meeting agenda was made by Randy Johnson and seconded by Nick Asbury.

Vote passed unanimously.

Dr. Eric Workman gave an overview of the County budget FY2016-2017.

#### ADOPTION OF THE FY17 SCHOOL BUDGET

\*\*\*\*\*MOTION to adopt the FY17 school budget in the amount of \$8,244,443 of which \$2,361,490 is local funding with the following covenants:

- All school employees receive a 2% salary or step increase, whichever is greater as mandated by the commonwealth of Virginia for FY17
- The increase in health insurance premiums in FY17 for employees be covered by the local appropriation above the state required local effort and not passed onto employees
- The school Board provide the Board of Supervisors on or before June 23, 2016, revised categorical amounts for the FY17 budget not to exceed the adopted budget amount of \$8,244,443

was made by Nick Asbury and seconded by Adam Kidd.

Vote on this motion was as follows: Nick Asbury, yes; Adam Kidd, yes; Randy Johnson, yes; and Karen Hodock, yes. The motion passed.

#### ADOPTION OF THE FY17 COUNTY BUDGET

\*\*\*\*\*MOTION to adopt the FY17 County Budget in the amount of \$20,901,409 with no increases in the local tax levies as compared to FY16 was made by Randy Johnson and seconded by Nick Asbury.

Vote on this motion was as follows: Randy Johnson, yes; Nick Asbury, yes; Adam Kidd, yes; and Karen Hodock, yes. The motion passed.

#### ADOPTION OF THE FY17 PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RELIEF ACT RATE (PPTRA)

\*\*\*\*\*MOTION to adopt the FY17 Personal Property Tax Relief Act Rate (PPTRA) of 39% (as provided by the Commissioner of Revenue) for FY17 was made by Adam Kidd and seconded by Nick Asbury.

Vote on this motion was as follows: Adam Kidd, yes; Nick Asbury, yes; Randy Johnson, yes; and Karen Hodock, yes. The motion passed.
