- 004** Request Board to authorize a public hearing for modification of local ordinance(s) associated with recent changes to the Code of Virginia. Public hearing is requested to be held at the June Board meeting:
- (a) Due to the passage of Virginia Code 17.1-279, it is requested to create local ordinance 20-3 *Assessment to Provide for Electronic Summons System*. Authorizes the County to assess an electronic summons system fee (\$5) as part of court costs to fund the software, hardware, and associated equipment for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons system.
 - (b) Due to the passage of Virginia Code 53-120, it is requested to amend local ordinance 20-1 *Assessment to Provide for Courthouse and Courtroom Security*. The proposed ordinance amends the assessment for courthouse security from \$10 to \$20 in accordance with recent changes to the state code.
- 005** Request Board to temporarily suspend portions of the recycling program.
- 006** Request Board to adopt FY20 budget transfer and appropriate funds (up to \$190,000) associated with debt payments for water revenue bonds dated 1995 and 1998.
