CALL TO ORDER

MAY 9, 2017 MEETING

****MOTION to approve the agenda as presented was by Randy Johnson and seconded by Adam Kidd.

Eric Workman made recommendation to adopt the FY18 School Board budget.

Randy Johnson asked what happens if we run short?

ADOPT SCHOOL BOARD BUDGET

****MOTION to adopt the FY18 school board budget in the amount of \$8,175,542 of which \$2,323,475 is local funding with the following covenants:

- \$386,272 of that total amount will be for contracted maintenance services provided by the County to the Schools per the Combined School Maintenance Contract:
- At a minimum \$70,000 of the \$87,573 of the overestimated FICA funds are to be used to reduce employee health insurance premiums:
- The School Board shall provide the Board of Supervisors on or before June 14, 2017, revised categorical amounts for the FY18 budget that include the changes due to combined maintenance services and reduced employee health care costs, not to exceed the adopted budget amount of \$8,175,342.
