Work begins on Rocky Gap Greenway

After years of planning and working to secure funding, the Rocky Gap Greenway Project gets underway.

County officials gathered Monday to kick off Phase I of the project, the construction of a sidewalk that stretches from Bland County High School to Highway 52. The sidewalk will feature street lights designed like Victorian-era lamp posts. Construction is projected to take a little more than six months.

"This is an exciting day for us," said Bland County Administrator, Eric Workman. During the ceremony he recalled visiting the Hawksbill Greenway in Luray, Virginia with Supervisor Nick Asbury and learning about greenway projects. Eventually, with assistance from Supervisor Karen Hodock, a community trip was made to Luray with Rocky Gap residents. Workman continued, "Upon our return, a community decision was made to move forward with the project and county employees begin working in partnership with the Rocky Gap Ruritan Club and residents of the community to develop and raise funding for the Rocky Gap Greenway."

The greenway project started thanks to seed money from the Wythe-Bland Foundation and, eventually, the county received grants to pay for the project.

"In total, nearly one million dollars has been raised in grant funding," Workman said, adding that the greenway will benefit the area's health and economy as residents and visitors enjoy the area.

Greenways are open space corridors that can be used for conservation, recreation, and/or alternative transportation. They often follow natural or existing land or water features such as stream valleys, rivers and utility corridors.

"It's a wonderful thing," said Sharon Puckett, who serves on the Rocky Gap Beautification Committee, as she held her grandson, River. "We will see people walk with their grandchildren, bike with their grandchildren, and just play and have fun in Rocky Gap."

She said she looks forward to decorating the street lamps for holidays.

"If we can get more people to enjoy Rocky Gap, they will realize how special it is and how much we all enjoy being here," Puckett said. "They will get a little piece of Rocky Gap as they walk and enjoy the peace and quiet and listen to the creek roll, all while getting exercise and walking the greenway."

The first segment of the project will be a sidewalk and street lighting along North Scenic Hwy from Woody's to the school. The next segment of the greenway project entails refurbishing the Phoenix Bridge crossing Wolf Creek and creating a 10-foot-wide walking/biking trail from the intersection of North Scenic Hwy and old Route 61 to the Veterans' Memorial.


